“Many are the afflictions of the righteous, But the LORD delivers him out of them all.” Psalms 34:19.

**The LORD will calm the storm of \_\_\_\_\_ when we trust Him enough to cry out to Him.**

“If disaster comes upon us--sword, judgment, pestilence, or famine--we will stand before this temple and in Your presence (for Your name is in this temple), and cry out to You in our affliction, and You will hear and save.” 2 Chronicles 20:9.

- Disasters are terrible. But they’re also an open door to reach out with the love of God.
- **Be Ready to cry out to God in your affliction, He will hear and save.**

**The LORD will calm the storm of \_\_\_\_\_ when we trust Him enough to be anxious for nothing.**

“Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.” Philippians 4:6,7.

- When people are discouraged, they can be more open to the One who can Encourage them.
- **Be Ready to Trust Him in the face of Anxiety and to encourage others.**

**The LORD will calm the storm of \_\_\_\_\_ when we trust His victory over death.**

“Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.” Hebrews 2:14,15.
