

**God's word reveals that calamity in life can be \_\_\_\_\_ to the fruit of our thoughts.**

Hear, O earth! Behold, I will certainly bring calamity on this people--**The fruit of their thoughts**, Because they have not heeded My words, Nor My law, but rejected it. (Jeremiah 6:19).

- God brought judgment upon man because the *thoughts* of his heart were evil continually. (Ge 6:5)
- **Jesus also warned against thinking evil in your hearts.** (Matthew 9:4).

**The mouth & tongue can potentially defile all of life \_\_\_\_\_ brought under control.** Rd Ja 3:1-11

- *Complaining and negativity reveal the condition of the heart.* Mt 12:33-37
- *Complaining and negativity will attempt to justify itself.* Pr 16:2.
- *Complaining and negativity will choose your friends for you.* Pr 13:20

**Negativity and complaining reflect what is going on \_\_\_\_\_ a person.**

“The mouth of the righteous is a well of life, But violence covers the mouth of the wicked.” Pr 10:11.

- **Fear..** The spies returned & made the congregation *complain* by bringing a bad report... Nu 14:36
- **Unmet Expectations...** “... *complainers* were destroyed by the destroyer.” 1 Co 10:8-10.
- **Lack of Knowledge...** “My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Hosea 4:6.
- **Bitterness of Soul...** “I will *complain* in the bitterness of my soul.” Job 7:11.
- **Unbelief...** They did not believe His word, But *complained* in their tents,... Psalms 106:24,25.
- I *complained* & my spirit was overwhelmed. *Selah*” Ps 77:3
- **Faulty Standards and Comparisons...** They were not wise for comparing. 2 Co 10:12

**God wants His people to do all things without complaining so we may \_\_\_\_\_ as lights in the world.**

“Do all things without complaining and disputing, that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, holding fast the word of life, so that I may rejoice in the day of Christ that I have not run in vain or labored in vain.” Philippians 2:14-16.

- **WE MUST HAVE OUR THINKING TRANSFORMED!**

**Transformational Thinking is a result of the \_\_\_\_\_ of the mind with the Word of God.**

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.” Romans 12:1,2.

- Commit your works to the LORD, And your **thoughts** will be established. (Pr 16:3).
- When we trust in the mind of Christ, God will reveal negative thinking... (Php 3:15,16).
- The Bible is inspired and the Holy Spirit will use it to get your thinking straight. (Ps 119:11).

**Transformational Thinking uses the renewed mind in a way that \_\_\_\_\_ love for God.**

“And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.’ This is the first commandment. “And the second, like it, is this: ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ There is no other commandment greater than these.”” Mark 12:30,31.

- Loving God with your mind involves *what* you think about. (Php 4:8-9). Thought Filter!
- Loving God with your mind involves *how* you think. (2 Co 10:4-5). Every thought captive!
- Loving God with your mind involves *what you do* with what you think. (2 Co 5:11) Persuade men!

**Transformational Thinking \_\_\_\_\_ the mind to think God's thoughts after Him.**

Let the wicked forsake his way, And the unrighteous man his **thoughts**; Let him return to the LORD, And He will have mercy on him; And to our God, For He will abundantly pardon. “For My **thoughts** are not your **thoughts**, Nor are your ways My ways,” says the LORD. “For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My **thoughts** than your **thoughts**. (Isaiah 55:7-9).

- We pattern our mind when we think God's words into our hearts and then **talk** of them. Dt 6:4-12

**Transformational Thinking is \_\_\_\_\_ by a dynamic relationship with the inspired Holy Scriptures.**

But you must continue in the things which you have learned and been assured of, knowing from whom you have learned them, and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness,” 2 Ti 3:14-16
