The offspring of Judah reveal some very powerful principles about _____ through life.

"The sons of Judah *were* Perez, Hezron, Carmi, Hur, and Shobal." 1 Chronicles 4:1

- **Perez:** (Breach, Cut off, Divider). *Perez will cut off the tactics of the enemy.*
- **Hezron:** (Shut in, Surround, Shield). *Hezron navigates you behind the shield of faith.*
- **Carmi** (Caleb): (Vinedresser Harvester). *Carmi navigates you into the harvest of blessing.*
- **Hur:** (Noble, Liberty) *Hur navigates you into freedom from bondage.*
- **Shobal:** (Embracer of Corn, Wanderer, Traveler, Pioneer) *Shobal navigates you into opportunity.*

Echo Navigation through praise gives us the _____ to make the enemy our prey.

"Praise the LORD! Sing to the LORD a new song, *And* His praise in the assembly of saints. Let Israel rejoice in their Maker; Let the children of Zion be joyful in their King. Let them praise His name with the dance; Let them sing praises to Him with the timbrel and harp. For the LORD takes pleasure in His people; He will beautify the humble with salvation. Let the saints be joyful in glory: Let them sing aloud on their beds. *Let* the high praises of God *be* in their mouth, *And* a two-edged sword in their hand, To execute vengeance on the nations, *And* punishments on the peoples; To bind their kings with chains, *And* their nobles with fetters of iron; To execute on them the written judgment--This honor have all His saints. Praise the LORD!" Psalms 149:1-9

- Praise navigates into victory. 2 Ch 20:15-22. Judah first. "Praise is the song of the supernatural".
- *Send out praise and God echoes back with victory over the enemy. Praise leads to Triumph!*

Echo Navigation through praise allows us to be surrounded with the _____ of the LORD.

But let all those rejoice who put their trust in You; Let them ever shout for joy, because You defend them; Let those also who love Your name Be joyful in You. For You, O LORD, will bless the righteous; With favor You will surround him as *with* a shield." Psalms 5:7-12

- "For the LORD God *is* a sun and shield; The LORD will give grace and glory; No good *thing* will He withhold From those who walk uprightly." Psalms 84:11; See also Ps 3:3
- *Send out praise and God echoes back with protection and favor.*

Echo Navigation through praise bounces back the vibrations of the _____ of the LORD.

Bless the LORD, O my soul: And all that is within me, *bless* His holy name! Bless the LORD, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies, Who satisfies your mouth with good *things*, *So that* your youth is renewed like the eagle's." Psalms 103:1-5

- Praise navigates us into where the blessing is flowing and the burdens can be lifted. Is 61:3.
- *Send out praise and God echoes back with blessing.*

Echo Navigation through praise invites the _____ of the LORD that leads to deliverance.

My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me? *Why are You so far* from helping Me. *And from* the words of My groaning? O My God, I cry in the daytime, but You do not hear; And in the night season, and am not silent. But You *are* holy, Enthroned in the praises of Israel. Our fathers trusted in You; They trusted, and You delivered them. They cried to You, and were delivered; They trusted in You, and were not ashamed." Psalms 22:1-5
